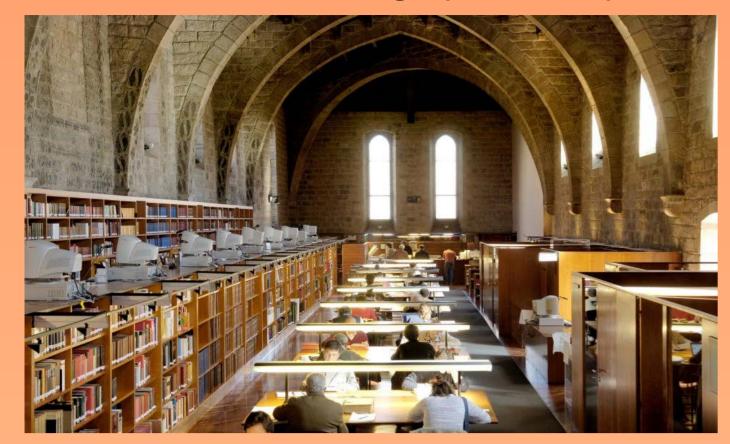
The Biblioteca de Catalunya

Working for the present and the future

The Biblioteca de Catalunya is the national library of Catalonia. Founded in 1907 its mission is to gather, preserve and disseminate the bibliographical output of Catalonia in any format or support.



Since the beginning of this century the Biblioteca de Catalunya has paid special attention to the digital context. 2004 may be considered the starting point on digital matter, when the Governing Board of the library approved its first strategic plan, where three lines of activity were highlighted to be focused on: the improvement of virtual services for users, the dissemination of digitized documents through the Internet, and the harvesting of the Catalan web. These lines were reinforced in the following strategic documents. Going after these objectives

in 2005 the Biblioteca de Catalunya set up:

ARCA (Arxiu de Revistes Catalanes Antigues=Old Catalan Serials Archive), and

MDC (Memòria Digital de Catalunya=Digital Memory of Catalonia), together with the Consortium of University Libraries (CBUC). Both portals for digitized collections

PADICAT (Patrimoni Digital de Catalunya=Digital Heritage of Catalonia), the Catalan web archive.

in 2007-2008 it started its participation in *Google Books* project and *Europeana*.

in 2011, to meet the needs generated by the digital outcome, the library developed COFRE (Conservem per al Futur Recursos electrònics= We preserve for the Future Electronic Resources), a repository of digital preservation.

PADICAT and COFRE are two complementary actions to guarantee the preservation of the digital Catalan heritage and its transmission for the next generations
